“YOUTH IN ACTION” PROGRAM

“Youth in Action” is the program for youth created by the European Union in order to promote the active European citizenship, solidarity, tolerance amongst young Europeans and their involvement in forging the Union’s future.

The program promotes mobility inside and outside the EU’s borders, non-formal learning and intercultural dialogue, encouraging integration of young Europeans, regardless of their educational, social or cultural background.

“Youth in Action” is a program for all young Europeans.



General overview:

“The ruins speak participative democracy in interactive theatre” project involves 30 young participants from 3 countries and 6 partners Turkey, Greece and Romania. The project aims to develop a positive attitude and the capacity of the young people to participate in the democratic system as active citizens.

During the 11 days of intensive non-formal program the participants will develop knowledge of democratic systems in the partner countries, history of developing a democratic process in our countries, skills to survey the public opinion on the democratic issues in the community, to organize a public theater representation and to promote active citizenship in general and solidar common actions and reactions of the citizens in the legislative/political process.





Project's objectives:

Encouraging an activ-participative attitude towards the democratic mechanisms for 30 participants from 3 countries for 10 days.

Facilitating the structural dialogue and strategic cooperation between 30 participants and the local authorities.
